



FOOD BANK Your donations change lives can you help those in need?

Since the end of March 2020 Four Greens Community Trust, in partnership with Whitleigh Big Local, St Chads Church and the Salvation Army, have provided an emergency response service to our community that has supported over 160 families and individuals in the Honicknowle, Whitleigh, Ernesettle and Manadon communities.

This community response has included a prescription and food pick up service, the provision of one off emergency cash payments to support with energy costs and for those most in need the delivery of food parcels. As the economic impact of Covid-19 deepens and more of our local community, many who are currently either on zero hours contracts or in low paid jobs either see their jobs being made redundant or their hours reduced the need for food parcels to be provided has never been greater.



FGCT is currently delivering over 65 food parcels a week to the PL5 area. Referrals are being made to us from a variety of organisations including churches, Plymouth City Council, The Salvation Army, Barnardos, Livewell and local organisations such as Whitleigh Big Local, the Phoenix Centre and Plymouth Community Homes.

The Covid-19 pandemic has highlighted the level of food poverty within our community and as a result of this Four Greens Community Trust and its partners have agreed that this is a service that we need to continue as the need is great and is only going to increase. Our existing service has been funded thanks to the generosity of our local community who helped us to raise over £12,000. In addition, we were successful in a partnership Bid with St Matthias Church to receive 10 weeks of food funded by government department DEFRA.

In order for us to continue this vital service long term we are asking our friends, members, and partners to consider making a small monthly donation to the Four Greens Community Trust that will go towards food for the parcels being delivered.

We have received many testimonials about the difference the food parcels make but the one that sums up the sentiments best is one received from a family that were referred to us by Barnardos and were experiencing multiple issues including the mother reporting domestic abuse. "The food parcels we receive mean that our whole family, but particularly my two children can eat properly and with everything going on in our lives this is a vital level of support for us at this time. Thank you so much".
